ABSTRACT

Photographs taken by Clav Snow while he attended South Dakota State College in the 1930s. Photographs are images of Hobo Day, Military Field Day Exercises, campus buildings, and friends.

BIOGRAPHICAL HISTORY

Clav Snow was from Onaka, South Dakota. He attended South Dakota State College in 1930, in the engineering program. He was a military cadet in Company B, 4th squad. He died at the infirmary in January.

CONTENTS NOTE

This collection contains photographs taken by Clav Snow during his time as a student at South Dakota State College in the early 1930s. The images document campus life and student activities, including Hobo Day celebrations, military Field Day Exercises, candid gatherings, and academic settings such as

a psychology class. Also featured are photographs of the SDSC Boxing Club, campus buildings and landmarks, and fellow students. The collection offers a visual record of student experiences and campus culture during that period.
